

How to Get Rid of Fleas on Cats

For those who own cats, how to get rid of fleas on cats is a common question. If you have a cat and it has fleas on it, you sure are in a mess for two reasons. Because most of the cats hate to be bathed, there are many probable chances that it will resist. You could do one thing in this regard, that first put the flea shampoo or flea repellent on the body of the cat and wash it off as instructed on its user manual. However, if your cat has been having fleas for a long time, there are chances he or she will not resist much.

One of the most important things to do to get rid of fleas on cats is clean its bed with hot water. This will not only clean the cat cushion but also make sure that if there are fleas on it, they do not last any longer. The reason we cleaned rest of the house and the cathouse first is that when you are done with cat cleaning, fleas won't come back again. Don't be content that once you are done with the cat bathing, you won't have to bother doing it again. Even if your cat is behaving normally, you'd have to give her an anti-flea bathe every day for three days at least.

In addition to this, you will have to take a lot of care for the next few days to ensure that your cat and your house remain flea free. If your cat starts scratching her body again, this means that your whole practice didn't go that well and you have to start over again.
